

## Prerequisite Coursework for TWU Houston Physical Therapy School

Successful completion (C or above) of:

- 1) Two semesters of biology or zoology with laboratory (courses not accepted as meeting these prerequisites are biology for non-science majors, anatomy, physiology, Kinesiology, botany, and ecology).
  - We recommend BIOS 201 and 202 as well as BIOS 211 and one of the following: BIOS 311, BIOS 312, BIOS 313, BIOS 314, BIOS 315
- 2) Two semesters of chemistry with laboratory.
  - We recommend CHEM 121 & 122 with laboratory. CHEM 151 & 152 with laboratory are also accepted.
- 3) Two semesters of basic physics with laboratory (physics for non-science majors does not meet this prerequisite).
  - We recommend PHYS 125 & 126 with laboratory. PHYS 101 & PHYS 102 are also accepted.
- 4) One semester of college algebra and one semester of college trigonometry or one semester of precalculus or one semester of calculus.
  - See during advising about meeting this requirement.
- 5) Six hours of psychology (excluding statistics).
  - We recommend PSYC 101 and one of the following: PSYC 202, PSYC 203, PSYC 221
- 6) One semester of statistics.
  - We recommend STAT 280
- 7) One semester of general physiology (preferably human); or two semesters of anatomy and physiology; or one semester of anatomy and physiology plus one semester of exercise physiology.
  - We recommend KINE 301. (Our department offerings cover the prerequisite in several ways.)
- 8) Competency in medical terminology.
  - We recommend HEAL 151 (starting Spring 2002)
